



Research Intern - Gender Employment Segregation

The Science Division, New York University Abu Dhabi, seeks to recruit an intern to work in the position: Research Assistant, on psychological research into the underpinnings of gender employment segregation.

The successful applicant will work on various research-related tasks, including running experimental sessions, recruiting and scheduling research participants, proofreading and bibliography work, library cleaning and maintenance, performing literature searches, programming Qualtrics surveys, summarizing research articles, gathering data from open sources, and other miscellaneous administrative and research tasks. Training will be provided. Our laboratory is currently focused on several projects on the psychological underpinnings of gender employment segregation, with the overarching goal of understanding the individual, interpersonal, and societal factors that contribute to the disparate representation of women and men in stereotypical social and professional roles. The candidate will work in the Psychology program within the [Social Roles and Beliefs lab](#), joining a dynamic team consisting of PhD-level scientists and undergraduate students.

Applicants must have excellent communication skills, both written and oral, an interest in the psychology of gender segregation, and they must be able to provide at least one professional or academic reference. In addition to these requirements, the ideal candidate will preferably also have past work experience in a research environment, past involvement with psychological research, academic exposure to social psychology (i.e., courses in social psychology, stereotyping and prejudice, gender, sexuality, etc.; psychology major/minor a plus), past experience using Qualtrics or other survey development platforms, knowledge of MS Excel, and knowledge of SPSS, R, or Stata for data analysis.

The internship opportunity is competitive. Applications will be accepted during a short timeframe during Spring and Fall terms. Shortlisted candidates will be notified within a month of the application deadline.
