HISTORY OF NEW YORK UNIVERSITY

Since its founding in 1831, NYU has been an innovator in higher education, reaching out to an emerging middle class, embracing an urban identity and professional focus, and promoting a global vision that informs its 20 schools and colleges.

Today, that trailblazing spirit makes NYU one of the most prominent and respected research universities in the world, featuring top ranked academic programs and accepting fewer than one in eight undergraduates. Anchored in New York City and with degree granting campuses in Abu Dhabi and Shanghai as well as 13 study away sites throughout the world, NYU is a leader in global education, with more international students and more students studying abroad than any other US university.

NYU students come from nearly every state and 133 countries, and the university draws upon the diverse backgrounds of our faculty, staff, and students, ensuring its scholarship and teaching benefit from a wide range of perspectives. NYU takes seriously its role as an engine of social mobility, and stands out among the top US universities in its diverse student body, including low-income and first-generation students.

Now among the largest private universities in the US, NYU provides a rigorous, demanding education to more than 65,000 students and undertakes USD 1.27 billion in research annually. It counts among its faculty, recipients of the highest scholarly honors and is a top producer of patents and revenue from licensing among US universities. NYU has a vast network of alumni who have gone on to succeed across professions, from the sciences to the arts and government, throughout the world.

HISTORY OF NEW YORK UNIVERSITY ABU DHABI

The groundwork for NYU Abu Dhabi was laid long before the students we celebrate today arrived on campus. Conceived in 2007, the idea for the University was built on the goal to create a world-class American liberal arts and research institution in the United Arab Emirates, offering an unparalleled educational opportunity that would attract the brightest students and scholars from the Emirates and around the world.

NYU Abu Dhabi launched its first community educational program in 2008: the Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Scholars Program. This annual eight-month enrichment and leadership development program is for top undergraduate students enrolled in the UAE's three federal institutions of higher education. In July 2011, the University launched the Summer Academy, an 18-month program designed to strengthen the academic profiles of highly motivated Emirati high school students.

Also in 2008, The NYUAD Institute hosted its inaugural public event to launch its series of scholarly and public programs, including academic conferences, workshops, lectures, film series, and performances. The Institute offers a platform for intellectual discourse in the capital, and to date has hosted more than 1,300 lectures, conferences, screenings, and workshops.

Launched in 2010 as a world-class center of cutting-edge and innovative research, scholarship, and cultural activity, the Research Institute has established more than 80 faculty labs and projects, and 20 distinctive research centers led by accomplished thought leaders, spanning science, technology, and engineering.

In November 2013, Her Excellency Shamma Al Mazrui, UAE's Minister of Community Development, who was then a member of NYUAD's senior class, was recognized as the University's first Rhodes Scholar. Since then, 21 additional students have been selected to join the community of scholars at Oxford University.

In September 2021, NYUAD celebrated its 10-year anniversary. Students have gone on to hold positions in some of the world's biggest organizations and continued their education in some of the world's leading universities. Of all NYUAD graduates, 94 percent were in employment or further study six months after receiving their degrees. In just over ten years, NYUAD has grown to a student population of 2,200 from over 120 countries, speaking more than 115 languages.





BIOGRAPHIES

EVAN R. CHESLER

Chair of the New York University Board of Trustees

Evan R. Chesler is a retired partner of Cravath, Swaine & Moore, LLP. He was the Firm's presiding partner from 2007 to 2012 and the Firm's chairman from 2013 to 2021, the first person ever to have been given that title. He handled a wide variety of litigation, including antitrust, intellectual property, and securities, for clients in virtually every industry. In addition to serving on the NYU Board of Trustees, Chesler is chair of the NYU Faculty of Arts and Science Board and a member of the NYU School of Law Foundation Board of Trustees. He is a distinguished scholar at NYU School of Law, founder and chair of the NYU Lawyer Alumni Mentoring Program (LAMP), and a member of the Board of Advisors for the Center on Civil Justice at NYU School of Law. He was also chair of the Board of Trustees of the New York Public Library from 2014-2022 and president of the Institute of Judicial Administration. He is a member of the Council of the American Law Institute.

LINDA G. MILLS

President, New York University

Linda G. Mills, JD, LCSW, PhD, is the 17th president of New York University and the Lisa Ellen Goldberg Professor of Social Work, Public Policy, and Law. Mills is also a fellow of the American Academy of Social Work and Social Welfare. Her research funded by the National Science Foundation and the National Institute of Justice has reshaped the treatment of domestic violence and her restorative justice-based programs are currently being adopted in several jurisdictions. She is a widely published author of articles appearing in *Harvard Law Review*, *Cornell Law Review*, *Journal of Experimental Criminology*, among others. Her books have been published by Princeton University Press, University of Michigan Press, Springer, and Basic Books. As a filmmaker, she has produced award-winning documentaries that have debuted at Tribeca Film Festival and screened worldwide.

BIOGRAPHIES

MARIËT WESTERMANN

Vice Chancellor, New York University Abu Dhabi

Mariët Westermann returned to NYU Abu Dhabi as Vice Chancellor and Professor of Arts and Humanities in 2019, having served as the first provost from 2007 to 2010. The 2024 Commencement is Dr. Westermann's last in her current role, as she has been named the director and CEO of the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum and Foundation, a constellation of four museums in New York, Venice, Bilbao, and soon, Abu Dhabi, starting June 1.

Between her engagements at NYUAD Dr. Westermann served as executive vice president of the Mellon Foundation in New York. Earlier in her career she was director and Paulette Goddard Professor at NYU's Institute of Fine Arts, associate director of research at the Clark Art Institute, and a tenured faculty member at Rutgers University.

Dr. Westermann is a widely published scholar on the art of the Netherlands, her native country, and on higher education, the humanities, cultural heritage, and diversity and inclusion.

Her current research is focused on Gardens of Eden in the Abrahamic faith communities. She earned her bachelor's degree, magna cum laude, at Williams College, where she was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, and she received her master's and PhD degrees from NYU's Institute of Fine Arts.

ARLIE PETTERS

Provost, New York University Abu Dhabi

Arlie Petters joined NYU Abu Dhabi in 2020 from Duke University, where he was the Benjamin Powell Distinguished Professor of Mathematics, former Dean of Academic Affairs for Trinity College of Arts and Sciences, and Associate Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education.

Prior to joining Duke, Petters served as an Assistant Professor of Mathematics at Princeton University and an Instructor of Pure Mathematics at Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

As a prolific and award-winning scholar, Dr. Petters has published numerous articles in the top-tier journals of his field and has written five books. His principal research interests are mathematical physics and scientific methods in business administration. He pioneered the mathematical theory of weak-deflection gravitational lensing and advanced innovative applications of the theory.

Dr. Petters received his PhD in mathematics from MIT, and has a BA and MA in mathematics and physics from Hunter College of the City University of New York.

BIOGRAPHIES

OUIDED BOUCHAMAOU

*Professor of Practice in Diplomacy and Conflict Resolution,
NYU Abu Dhabi*

Dr. Ouided Bouchamaoui, co-laureate of the 2015 Nobel Peace Prize, recently joined NYU Abu Dhabi as a Professor of Practice in Diplomacy and Conflict Resolution in the Division of Arts and Humanities. She lends her profound expertise to the Legal Studies program.

Dr. Bouchamaoui has long been recognized as a leading figure in nurturing democracy and economic growth in Tunisia. As the trailblazing president of UTICA, the Tunisian Confederation of Industry, Trade, and Handicrafts, she became the first woman to attain this pivotal role. She holds a Master's in Public Administration from Harvard Kennedy School (2022), a Master's in International Business and International Trade Law, and has received numerous honorary doctorates and awards, including the "Best Business Woman of the Arab World" by the Group of Seven (G7) in 2013.

In 2013, Dr. Bouchamaoui co-founded "The Tunisian National Dialogue Quartet" which played a crucial role in post-revolution Tunisia and won the Nobel Peace Prize in 2015. Her leadership in business and politics is further highlighted by accolades such as the Grand Officer of the Order of the Republic (Tunisia), the Royal Order of the Polar Star (Sweden), and the Legion d'Honneur (France).

Dr. Bouchamaoui has been a "Business for Peace Honoree" and a member of the Oslo Business for Peace Award Committee since January 2016. Her distinguished career, marked by global business engagement, extensive training initiatives, and professional consultation, aligns perfectly with NYU Abu Dhabi's academic mission. She is a passionate advocate for gender diversity and women's empowerment in the Arab world.

HUMAID ABDULLA ALJAILANI, BA

Welcome Speaker Class of 2024

Humaid is from Abu Dhabi, UAE, and was raised in Abu Dhabi, New York, and Berlin. He double majored in Philosophy and Social Research and Public Policy and minored in Economics. Humaid co-founded the Domestic Students' Advisory Board, which is part of the student government, and also served in several student government committees. He has been actively involved in the University's research missions, specifically in the fields of behavioral economics and education.

STEFAN MITIKJ, BA

Student Speaker Class of 2024

Stefan hails from Skopje, embracing a rich blend of Macedonian and Serbian familial heritage. He majored in Political Science and Social Research and Public Policy. Stefan served in the Student Government, was a Managing Editor of The Gazelle, and a Resident Assistant amongst several other student roles. He has been actively involved in the South Slavic Club and the UAE Majlis, and served as a Student Embassy Ambassador Liaison for the Macedonian and Serbian embassies.

NYU ABU DHABI PIANO PRIZE

Awarded to Sarah Al Towaity, BS

The Piano Prize, being presented for the fourth time this year, is awarded annually to a senior graduating from NYU Abu Dhabi who best exemplifies former provost Fabio Piano's selfless devotion to science and to the wellbeing and excellence of our university. The Piano Prize will forever remind our academic community of the combined importance of research, excellence, and service in the life of NYUAD, on the model that Fabio Piano set for us in our first decade.

NYU ABU DHABI AL BLOOM SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to Omar Rayyan, Class of 2025

Alfred H. Bloom Scholarship for Global Liberal Arts celebrates and commemorates the legacy of NYU Abu Dhabi's founding vice-chancellor. It is designated annually to one NYU Abu Dhabi third-year student to recognize their demonstrated commitment to the global liberal arts, as evidenced through excellence in cross-cultural communication and exchange, interdisciplinary studies, social impact and innovation, critical thinking, and experiential learning.

NYU ABU DHABI DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

Awarded to Farah Mohmad, Class of 2015

The Distinguished Alumni Award, which is being presented for the the sixth time, honors an NYU Abu Dhabi graduate who exemplifies the commitment to intellectual and creative advance, the embrace and conceptual and ethical complexity, and the dedication to a more united, generous, and responsive world, which are at the core of NYU Abu Dhabi.

DISTINGUISHED TEACHING AWARD

Awarded to Ilya Spitkovsky, Professor of Mathematics, NYU Abu Dhabi

Established in 1987, the prestigious NYU Distinguished Teaching Award recognizes full-time faculty members for their commitment to teaching excellence. To be eligible for a Distinguished Teaching Award, professors must have at least 10 years of service to NYU. Professors are nominated by students, alumni, and colleagues who submit letters of recommendation to school committees. After a strict school-level review process, each school nominates its top candidate to a university-wide board. Distinguished Teaching Award winners develop innovative pedagogy that advances their academic discipline and are dedicated to mentoring students in their scholarship, critical thinking skills, and future careers.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn today by participants in these Commencement exercises follow the tradition of the attire of teachers and students in the Middle Ages.

Those who have earned the bachelor's degree wear a gown with semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front, and intricate shirring across the shoulders and back; the gown is also distinguished by long, pointed sleeves. The holders of the master's degree wear a similar gown, but the sleeve is square and closed at the end. Bachelor's and master's degree recipients wear the traditional square mortarboard with black tassel. Honors Scholars, baccalaureate degree recipients who have earned a 3.5 or higher cumulative grade point average based on a minimum of 30 graded credits, wear a distinctive gold tassel adorned with the New York University Honors Scholar emblem in cloisonné.

Those possessing the doctoral degree wear gowns with broad velvet panels down the front. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color of the field of learning represented by the degree.

Much of the color and meaning of the costumes is found in the hoods worn by holders of doctoral and master's degrees. These are silk-lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree.



HONORS

NEW YORK UNIVERSITY HONORS SCHOLARS

The New York University Honors Scholar award (which is also known as the Founders' Day Award at NYU's Washington Square campus) is given to the top 40 percent of students in the graduating class. These students have emerged as exceptional scholars in NYU Abu Dhabi's highly selective and competitive academic community. University Honors Scholars wear a golden tassel in place of the standard tassel during Commencement.

PHI BETA KAPPA

As a part of New York University, NYU Abu Dhabi's top students are considered for membership in NYU's chapter of The Phi Beta Kappa Society, the oldest academic honor society in the United States. Membership in Phi Beta Kappa shows commitment to the liberal arts and sciences, and to freedom of inquiry and expression. Weight is given to the breadth and depth of the student's study in the liberal arts, and they are required to complete coursework in certain specified areas as well as exhibit good moral character. The final selection for membership is by a committee of faculty in New York who are themselves members of Phi Beta Kappa chapters.

GRADUATION HONORS

NYU Abu Dhabi, following the practice of US colleges and universities, awards honors based on the cumulative grade point average at the time of graduation. Summa cum laude (highest honors) is awarded to the top 5 percent of students within each division. Magna cum laude (high honors) is awarded to the next 10 percent of students within each division. Cum laude (honors) is awarded to the next 15 percent of students within each division. As final grade point averages were not available at the time of printing, these awards will be announced at a later date.
