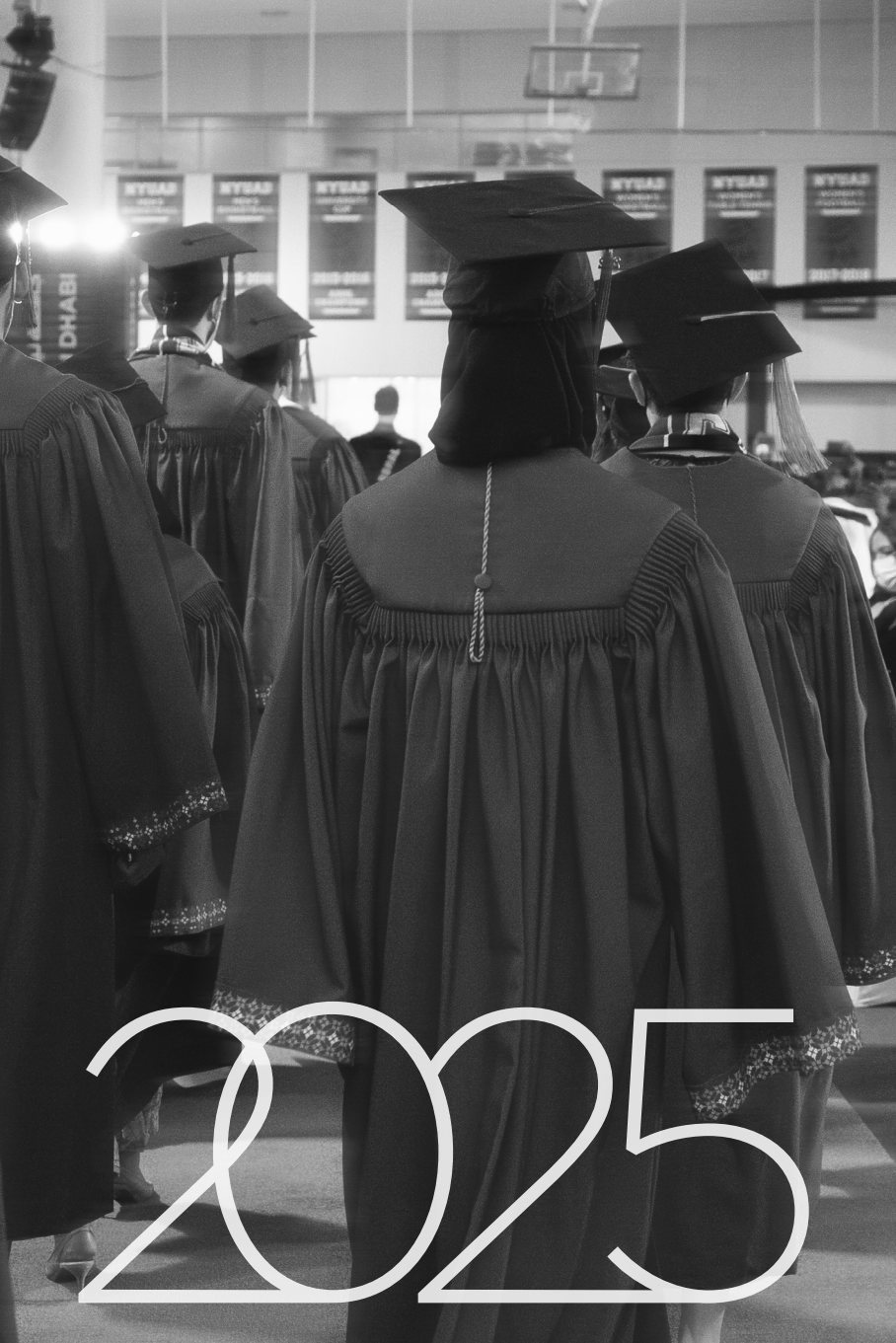

HISTORY OF NEW YORK UNIVERSITY

Since its founding in 1831, NYU has been an innovator in higher education, reaching out to an emerging middle class, embracing an urban identity and professional focus, and promoting a global vision that informs its 20 schools and colleges.

Today, that trailblazing spirit makes NYU one of the most prominent and respected research universities in the world, featuring top-ranked academic programs and accepting fewer than one in eight undergraduates. Anchored in New York City and with degree-granting campuses in Abu Dhabi and Shanghai as well as 13 study away sites throughout the world, NYU is a leader in global education, with more international students and more students studying abroad than any other US university.

NYU students come from nearly every state and 133 countries, and the university draws upon the diverse backgrounds of our faculty, staff, and students, ensuring its scholarship and teaching benefit from a wide range of perspectives. NYU takes seriously its role as an engine of social mobility, and stands out among the top US universities in its representation of low-income and first-generation students within its community.

The largest private research university in the US, NYU provides a rigorous, demanding education to more than 65,000 students and undertakes USD 1.27 billion in research annually. It counts among its faculty recipients of the highest scholarly honors and is a top producer of patents and revenue from licensing among US universities. NYU has a vast network of alumni who have gone on to succeed across professions, from the sciences to the arts and government, throughout the world.

HISTORY OF NEW YORK UNIVERSITY ABU DHABI

The groundwork for NYU Abu Dhabi was laid long before the undergraduates we celebrate today arrived on campus. Conceived in 2007, the idea for the University was built on the goal to create a world-class American liberal arts and research institution in the United Arab Emirates, offering an unparalleled educational opportunity that would attract the brightest students and scholars from the Emirates and around the world.

NYU Abu Dhabi launched its first community educational program in 2008: the Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Scholars Program. This annual nine-month program brings together top undergraduate students from the UAE's three federal universities for an intensive enrichment and leadership development experience, focused on academic writing, critical thinking, and public speaking skills that complement and enhance the core courses students take both at NYUAD and their home universities. In July 2011, the University launched the Summer Academy, an 18-month program designed to strengthen the academic profiles of highly motivated Emirati high school students. The program provides intensive instruction in writing, public speaking, and leadership, preparing students for success at top universities.

Also in 2008, The NYUAD Institute hosted its inaugural public event to launch its series of scholarly and public programs, including academic conferences, workshops, lectures, film series, and performances. The Institute offers a platform for intellectual discourse in the capital, and to date has hosted more than 1,300 lectures, conferences, screenings, and workshops.

Established in 2010, the NYUAD Research Institute serves as a premier global center for groundbreaking research, pioneering scholarship and vibrant cultural engagement, driving innovations and shaping

excellence across disciplines. Over the past 15 years, the Research Institute has sponsored 34 distinct projects, ranging from large-scale multidisciplinary centers to small scale feasibility studies. Since its inception, the centers have collectively generated over 2,000 publications, 348 conference proceedings and 146 books, and 99 book chapters.

In November 2013, Her Excellency Shamma Al Mazrui, Minister of Community Development, who was then a member of NYUAD's senior class, was recognized as the University's first Rhodes Scholar. Since then, 23 additional students have been selected to join the community of scholars at Oxford University.

The Young Filmmakers Workshop Program was launched in 2015. This three-week summer program, a collaboration between Image Nation Abu Dhabi and NYU Abu Dhabi, offers Emirati high school students hands-on experience in storytelling, directing, and producing short films.

In September 2021, NYUAD celebrated its tenth anniversary. Students have gone on to hold positions in some of the world's biggest organizations and continued their education in some of the world's leading universities. Of all NYUAD graduates, 94 percent were in employment or further study six months after receiving their degrees. In just over ten years, NYUAD has grown to a student population of 2,000 from over 118 countries, speaking more than 115 languages.

The PhD Pathways Program at NYU Abu Dhabi was launched in 2023. This initiative aims to address the underrepresentation of Emirati PhDs and professors in higher education by providing mentorship, research experience, and academic development opportunities to NYUAD undergraduate students.





BIOGRAPHIES

EVAN R. CHESLER

Chair of the Arts and Science Board, Chair of the NYU Board of Trustees, and a member of the Board's Executive Committee

Evan Chesler is a retired partner of Cravath, Swaine and Moore LLP. He was the Firm's presiding partner from 2007 to 2012 and the Firm's chairman from 2013 to 2021, the first person ever to have been given that title. Chesler is a distinguished NYU alumnus who earned an A.B. in History with highest honors in 1970, an M.A. in Russian Area Studies in 1973, and a J.D. cum laude from NYU School of Law in 1975. A long-standing and dedicated member of the NYU community, he founded and chairs the Lawyer Alumni Mentoring Program (LAMP) at the College of Arts and Science, supporting pre-law students through mentoring and academic enrichment. He has endowed the Barbara and Evan Chesler Pre-law Program and the Chesler Scholarship for pre-law juniors. Chesler serves on the NYU School of Law Board of Trustees and its Executive Committee, and is an Advisory Board member of the Center on Civil Justice. NYU has recognized his service and has awarded him the NYU Alumni Meritorious Service Award.

LINDA G. MILLS

President, New York University

Linda G. Mills, JD, LCSW, PhD, is the 17th president of New York University and the Lisa Ellen Goldberg Professor of Social Work, Public Policy, and Law. Mills is also a fellow of the American Academy of Social Work and Social Welfare. Her research funded by the National Science Foundation and the National Institute of Justice has reshaped the treatment of domestic violence and her restorative justice-based programs are currently being adopted in several jurisdictions. She is a widely published author of articles appearing in Harvard Law Review, Cornell Law Review, Journal of Experimental Criminology, among others. Her books have been published by Princeton University Press, University of Michigan Press, Springer, and Basic Books. As a filmmaker, she has produced award-winning documentaries that have debuted at Tribeca Film Festival and screened worldwide.

BIOGRAPHIES

FABIO PIANO

Interim Vice Chancellor, New York University Abu Dhabi

Fabio Piano is the Interim Vice Chancellor and Chief Executive of NYU Abu Dhabi, and a Joint Distinguished Global Professor of Biology. A molecular biologist and renowned academic leader, he previously established the Center for Genomics and Systems Biology at NYU New York and served as NYUAD's founding Provost from 2010 to 2020, overseeing the creation of over 24 undergraduate majors, global PhD programs, and master's degrees.

Piano earned his Laurea from the University of Florence and completed his PhD in Biology at NYU. His research on gene regulation, embryonic development, and drug discovery has been published in leading journals such as *Nature*, *Science*, and *Cell*.

Known for his student-centered approach and global outlook, Piano continues to shape NYUAD's vision as a pioneering institution bridging cultures and disciplines.

ARLIE PETTERS

Provost, New York University Abu Dhabi

Arlie Petters joined NYU Abu Dhabi in 2020 from Duke University, where he was the Benjamin Powell Distinguished Professor of Mathematics, Dean of Academic Affairs for the Trinity College of Arts and Sciences, and Associate Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education.

Prior to joining Duke, Petters was on the faculty at Princeton University and MIT.

A mathematical physicist by training, Petters has authored five books and received numerous awards for his pioneering work in gravitational lensing.

Petters received his PhD in mathematics from MIT and holds a BA and an MA in mathematics and physics from Hunter College of the City University of New York.

BIOGRAPHIES

ANDREW JAY FEUSTEL

NASA Astronaut and Geophysicist

Andrew “Drew” Feustel, PhD, has logged more than 226 days in space across three NASA missions and has amassed a wealth of experience in deep-Earth research and space exploration. His extensive spacewalking expertise, nine spacewalks totaling over 60 hours, ranks him third among all US astronauts for cumulative time spent performing extravehicular activities.

In addition to his spacewalking achievements, Feustel served as the flight engineer and later as the commander of Expedition 55/56 aboard the International Space Station. He also held the position of acting Chief Astronaut at NASA and is currently the Lead Astronaut at Vast, an American aerospace company. His missions include STS-125, the final Hubble servicing mission, and STS-134 to deliver the Alpha Magnetic Spectrometer to the ISS. Before joining NASA in 2000, Feustel earned his PhD in Geological Sciences from Queen’s University, specializing in seismology.

KHALID ALZEYOUNDI, BS

Welcome Speaker Class of 2025

Khalid grew up in the UAE. He has served as Vice President of the UAE Majlis Student Interest Group (SIG) and a mentor in the Academic Enrichment Program. Khalid also chaired the National Military Service Initiative on the Domestic Student Advisory Board, advocating for students balancing military service and academics. He also represented the UAE at the GCC Youth Forum, fostering cross cultural exchange.

PAULINE WEE, BS

Student Speaker Class of 2025

Pauline Wee has a double major in Computer Science and Business, Organizations and Society and a minor in Interactive Media. She led The Design Collective and the Craft Circle Student Interest Groups (SIGs), and a number of on campus and research projects. She loves creating impact as a software engineer, designer, founder, and community leader.

NYU ABU DHABI PIANO PRIZE

Awarded to Corban Villa, BS, Class of 2025

The Piano Prize is awarded annually to a senior graduating from NYU Abu Dhabi who best exemplifies Interim Vice Chancellor Fabio Piano's selfless devotion to science and to the wellbeing and excellence of our University. The Piano Prize will forever remind our academic community of the combined importance of research, excellence, and service in the life of NYUAD, on the model that Fabio Piano set for us as Provost in our first decade.

NYU ABU DHABI AL BLOOM SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to Zhifei (Maggie) Li, Class of 2026

Alfred H. Bloom Scholarship for Global Liberal Arts celebrates and commemorates the legacy of NYU Abu Dhabi's founding Vice-Chancellor. It is designated annually to one NYU Abu Dhabi third-year student to recognize their demonstrated commitment to the global liberal arts, as evidenced through excellence in cross-cultural communication and exchange, interdisciplinary studies, social impact and innovation, critical thinking, and experiential learning.

NYU ABU DHABI ALUMNI LEADERSHIP AWARD

Awarded to Sandro Andric, Class of 2019

The Alumni Leadership Award honors an NYU Abu Dhabi graduate who continues to embody and expand the university's values of collaboration, innovation, and service to make an impact beyond themselves. This recipient is a risk-

taker who uses their professional and personal excellence to address humanity's shared challenges in ways that inspire their colleagues, peers, and the NYUAD community.

DISTINGUISHED TEACHING AWARD

Awarded to Adam Ramey, Associate Professor of Political Science

Established in 1987, the prestigious NYU Distinguished Teaching Award recognizes full-time faculty members for their commitment to teaching excellence. To be eligible for a Distinguished Teaching Award, professors must have at least 10 years of service to NYU. Professors are nominated by students, alumni, and colleagues who submit letters of recommendation to School committees. After a strict school-level review process, each School nominates its top candidate to a University-wide board. Distinguished Teaching Award winners develop innovative pedagogy that advances their academic discipline and are dedicated to mentoring students in their scholarship, critical thinking skills, and future careers.

THE PALM TEACHING AWARD

Awarded to Dania Zantout, Lecturer of Mathematics, and Djellel Difallah, Assistant Professor of Computer Science

Established to honor teaching excellence at NYU Abu Dhabi, the Palm Teaching Award recognizes faculty who demonstrate exceptional impact in areas such as student engagement, experiential learning, instructional mastery, and liberal arts curricular development. Inspired by the palm tree, whose deep roots represent a strong foundation of knowledge and whose branches and dates symbolize the

sharing of that knowledge across communities, the award reflects the central role of teaching at NYUAD, much like the palm trees at the heart of the campus. Eligible faculty must have taught at NYU Abu Dhabi for at least four years and be nominated by a colleague, alumni or students. A faculty committee reviews all nominations to select the winners.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn today by participants in these Commencement exercises follow the tradition of the attire of teachers and students in the Middle Ages.

Those who have earned the bachelor's degree wear a gown with semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front, and intricate shirring across the shoulders and back; the gown is also distinguished by long, pointed sleeves. The holders of the master's degree wear a similar gown, but the sleeve is square and closed at the end. Bachelor's and master's degree recipients wear the traditional square mortarboard with black tassel. Honors Scholars, baccalaureate degree recipients who have earned a 3.5 or higher cumulative grade point average based on a minimum of 30 graded credits, wear a distinctive gold tassel adorned with the New York University Honors Scholar emblem in cloisonné. Those possessing the doctoral degree wear gowns with broad velvet panels down the front. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color of the field of learning represented by the degree.

Much of the color and meaning of the costumes is found in the hoods worn by holders of doctoral and master's degrees. These are silk-lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree.

HONORS

NEW YORK UNIVERSITY HONORS SCHOLARS

The New York University Honors Scholar award (which is also known as the Founders' Day Award at NYU's Washington Square campus) is given to the top 40 percent of students in the graduating class. These students have emerged as exceptional scholars in NYU Abu Dhabi's highly selective and competitive academic community. University Honors Scholars wear a gold tassel in place of the standard tassel during Commencement.

PHI BETA KAPPA

As a part of New York University, NYU Abu Dhabi's top students are considered for membership in NYU's chapter of The Phi Beta Kappa Society, the oldest academic honor society in the United States. Membership in Phi Beta Kappa shows commitment to the liberal arts and sciences, and to freedom of inquiry and expression. Weight is given to the breadth and depth of the student's study in the liberal arts, and they are required to complete coursework in certain specified areas as well as exhibit good moral character. The final selection for membership is by a committee of faculty in New York who are themselves members of Phi Beta Kappa chapters.

GRADUATION HONORS

NYU Abu Dhabi, following the practice of US colleges and universities, awards honors based on the cumulative grade point average at the time of graduation. Summa cum laude (with highest honors) is awarded to the top 5 percent of students within each division. Magna cum laude (with high honors) is awarded to the next 10 percent of students within each division. Cum laude (with honors) is awarded to the next 15 percent of students within each division. As final grade point averages were not available at the time of printing, these awards will be posted to students' records at a later date.
