### Work in Progress

#### Oligarchy, democracy and 'la peur du déclassement'

I analyse the impact of the fear of losing social status on the levels of democratisation and economic growth. In a political economy model where education makes an individual's vote count and generate positive externality for all agents in the economy, I study the incentives for the elites to initiate a democratic transition by educating the masses when they care about both their status (relative position in the income distribution) and their absolute income. ### Neural Network Forecasting for Inflation in India: 2012 – 2017 (joint with Aniruddha Ghosh)

We attempt to evaluate the usefulness of neural networks in the context of inflation forecasting. Using India's monthly inflation (CPI) numbers from January 2012 to June 2017, we assess the neural net's performance (using Levenberg-Marquardt and the BIC algorithm) vis-a-vis univariate autoregressive models. #### **Role of behavior in political transitions** (joint with Felix S. Døssing)

We extend the theory of political transitions (Acemoglu and Robinson 2001, 2003, 2006) and propose a form of repeated-utlimatum bargaining game with taxation and efficiency losses. An implementation of the game in an experiment helps us analyse whether individuals care solely about economic outcomes or there are some non-pecuniary consequences that individuals take into consideration during political transitions and regime changes.
