

### Library Visiting Scholar Program

While the NYUAD Library exists primarily to serve the needs of NYUAD students and faculty, the library will make its resources available to members of the community who may benefit from their use. Accordingly, visiting scholar privileges will be provided to qualified individuals who complete an approval process and obtain the permission of the Library Director. Access to the campus, library and NYUAD resources is subject to the conditions and limitations in the terms of use.

**Applicants should explain what books or other resources they need that our library has.** Please consult our library catalog at <http://nyuad.nyu.edu/en/research/library.html>. The application should include the applicant's program and/or field of study, status (i.e. PhD, masters or undergraduate student, faculty, alum), and **identify specific resources he or she hopes to use at the NYUAD Library, for example, journal or book titles, names of databases, etc.**

Applicants should complete the application form and attach a photocopy of their passport or national ID document.

All applications will be reviewed by the Library Director. If approved, privileges are valid until August 1 of the coming year, but may be renewed by submitting an updated application. Granting of privileges is at the discretion of the Library Director and can be revoked at any time. Visiting scholars must agree to the conditions of use established by the library.

The NYUAD Library is unable to grant requests that are only for study space.

### Library Visiting Scholar Conditions of use

I agree to act as a respectful and courteous member of the academic community while engaged in library research and in all interactions with faculty, staff and students of NYUAD.

I understand that access to all library resources and assets is governed by license agreements, copyright laws, and policies established by the library.

I accept that priority and immediate access to resources will be reserved for NYUAD students, faculty, and authorized NYUAD affiliates, and agree that I will yield whenever my use of resources impedes use by these parties.

I understand that borrowing privileges and offsite electronic access are not included in the visiting scholar program.

Access to the library may be limited to certain hours or days of the week as established by the Library Director. Every effort will be made to make visiting scholars aware of any restrictions in availability.
